## **San Marino Policy Letter**

**SMPL – 2025-SEC-002**

**06 February 2025**

### **San Marino Ship Register SMSR**

**Reminder to Company Security Officers (CSOs) and Deputy Company Security Officers (DCSOs) on the need to acknowledge the communication regarding the adoption by San Marino maritime Administration of security level 2 (SL2) or security level 3 (SL3), and to give assurance on the enforcement, when it is the case, of the required protecting measures.**

TO: Recognised Organisations, Shipowners, Managers, Masters, Seafarers, SMSR partners, SMSR brokers, Surveyors, and the general public.

In accordance with section A/7.5 of the ISPS Code and paragraph 4.2 (Security levels) of the San Marino Policy Letter [SMPL-2021-SEC-014](#) dated 11th October 2021, each Company Security Officer (CSO) or Deputy Company Security Officer (DCSO), as the case might be, of ships flying the San Marino flag that receives via e-mail information from San Marino Ship Register (SMSR) on the adoption by the Administration of a Directive setting SL2 or SL3 (also published on the websites <https://www.smsr.sm/san-marino-directive/>), shall:

1. **Always**, acknowledge receipt to SMSR ([security@smsr.sm](mailto:security@smsr.sm)) of the relevant Directive relating to the adoption by the Administration of the SL2 or SL3. This is requested to the CSO/DCSO whether or not the company's ships he/she is responsible for are in a situation where a ship must immediately apply the Directive and implement the new security level (e.g.: Voyages in a specific geographical area; Type of ship; Type of cargo etc.);
2. **In addition**, if a ship is in a situation where she is required to adopt and enforce the higher security level, the CSO/DCSO must inform SMSR ([security@smsr.sm](mailto:security@smsr.sm)) of any inability of the relevant ship to implement, without undue delay, what is requested by the Administration and the Ship Security Plan (SSP) for the adopted new security level;
3. To provide the receipt acknowledgement provided for in the previous point 1, please consider the following instructions:
  - a) You will receive the Directive via email to the address you provided to the SMSR;
  - b) You must click on the red button.
